Drive across the Seri Wawasan Bridge, with its steel cables strung to look like a ship's sail, and you will understand the futuristic nature of Putrajaya. Catch a glimpse of the pink mosque, serene and welcoming across the rippling lake. Watch as a guide taps the rubber tree, and processes the rubber into smoked sheets. From rubber to cocoa to palm oil, trace Malaysia's agricultural history as you visit this 'living museum' with more than 170 types of plants.

Agricultural Heritage Park

A delightful addition to Putrajaya's modern atmosphere, the Agricultural Heritage Park essentially houses the plants which have played an important role during Malaysia's years as an agricultural based economy. Visitors who visit during fruit season will be able to take photos of trees such as the starfruit, rambutan, mango and jackfruit trees laden with fruits. In addition to the rubber processing plant, the pepper and coffee processing areas offer some interesting photo opportunities for shutterbugs.

Putrajaya Government Centre

Completely modern, the Putrajaya Government Centre houses numerous government complexes in buildings with unique architecture. From the famous Seri Wawasan Bridge to the mesmerizing man-made Putrajaya Lake, from the Prime Minister's office – Putra Perdana to the nearby Putra bridge, this Centre is a favourite location for photo opportunities particularly for wedding portraits.

Putrajaya Mosque

A beautiful light pink mosque which appears to float on the lake, the Putrajaya Mosque is, undoubtedly, the gem of Putrajaya. Incorporating inspirations from Morocco and ancient Persian Islamic art, it merges beauty with spiritual purpose. Non-muslims are welcomed to visit this work of art.
